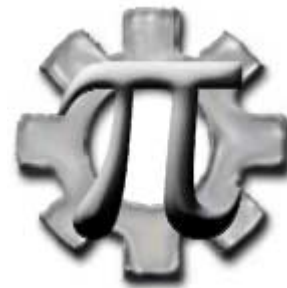
## Girls Night Out

### **Undertaker**
